What will I be tested on?	Vocabulary (synonyms) Word classes (subject terminology e.g. noun, verb, adverb,) Literary techniques (e.g. simile, metaphor) Information retrieval (finding specific information) Inference (Ability to 'read between the lines'.) Use of varied sentence structures, accuracy of SPaG
What is the structure of the assessment?	Read an unseen passage and then complete multiple choice questions on the above topics which allows us to then assess your different reading skills. There will also be a written element, covering aspects taught in lessons- use of varied and accurate sentence structure, accuracy of punctuation and use of vocabulary
What revision should I do?	Use your knowledge organiser and LSQ homework. Seneca.learning.org KS3 SPaG- 3.1 Grammar Bedrock Grammar additional practice. Review your TIN tasks and previous targets for writing.

Science

What will I be tested on?	We will be assessing the Energy topic, Particle model topic and your Science investigation skills.
What is the structure of the assessment?	<p>There are 2 parts to the assessment.</p> <p>Paper 1 - This is a set of multiple choice questions that focus on your knowledge and understanding of the energy topic.</p> <p>Paper 2 - You will answer 2 longer questions on this paper, one question will focus on writing a description of a Science idea or Scientific method. The other question will focus on your Science investigation skills, this may involve drawing a conclusion from data, suggesting an improvement for a method or analysing some data.</p>
What revision should I do?	<p>The questions will focus on knowledge and skills outlined in the Working Scientifically and Energy Knowledge organiser, you can complete self quizzing to revise the key terms and concepts.</p> <p>To supplement this you can access support via the BBC Bitesize website.</p>

What is the structure of the assessment?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Reading section - Read the texts in French/Spanish and answer the questions in English, translate sentences ★ Writing paper - multi-choice questions, translations into French/Spanish ★ Speaking - read a short text out loud and answer two questions given in advance by your teacher which you need to learn ★ Listening - dictation
What revision should I do?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Self quizzing using my knowledge organiser ★ Learn your speaking answers using look, cover, write, check and asking a parent/carer to test you on your answers

Art

What will I be tested on?	On the day you will create a tonal drawing of an image. You will have to use the grid method to draw the image and apply relevant tones and textures to the image you are drawing.
What is the structure of the assessment?	Students will be marked holistically against the 4 assessment objectives across all activities in their sketchbook, including the drawing task on the day.
What revision should I do?	Use the tracker in the front of your book to ensure you have completed all set work. You should also spend some time making further improvements.

Product Design

What will I be tested on?	One-point perspective drawing skills. To be able to produce a drawing that accurately shows perspective and depth.
What is the structure of the assessment?	A drawing task to produce a one-point perspective scene.
What revision should I do?	Practise your one point perspective drawing skills. Search for images on google and try to copy them, including all details and rendering on the drawing.

Music

What will I be tested on?	Your ability to perform a set of rhythmic patterns as part of a class ensemble. You will be assessed on the following key areas: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Confidence2. Technical Skill3. Fluency
What is the structure of the assessment?	You will have the lesson to prepare for your performance and then you will perform at the end of the lesson with the rest of the class.
What revision should I do?	No revision is needed for this assessment.

Performance

What will I be tested on?	You will create a performance highlighting your 5 Key acting skills; Voice, Facial Expression, Posture, Gesture and Movement. During this performance you will need to show focus and confidence ensuring that the performance is complete without breaking character.
What is the structure of the assessment?	You will have a lesson to prepare and then a lesson to perform.
What revision should I do?	Practice using your 5 Key acting skills and performing with confidence and focus.

PE

What will I be tested on?	Students will be observed demonstrating the five big ideas in the sports that they have been covering in recent lessons. The five big ideas are- Movement (Demonstrating Components of Fitness and Motor Skills), Space (Demonstrating how and when to use space), Timing (Demonstrating a combination of decision making,

	coordination and reaction time), Strategy (Demonstrating decision making adapting to different game scenarios (3v2 etc) and Communication (Interaction between team mates, competitors and officials).
What is the structure of the assessment?	Assessment is carried out whilst students demonstrate a range of core skills in isolated drills in a variety of activities on the sports that they have been covering for that term. The sports for this term are Rugby, Tag Rugby, Netball, Table Tennis, Fitness, Football and Dance- the sport varies by group.
What revision should I do?	Practice demonstrating the big ideas in the lessons leading up to the assessment. Come to clubs for extra practice and teacher support.

Computing
