The role: At Five Acres High School we are looking to appoint one Character Education Deputy Student for each of our five school values. The role will see you taking the lead on promoting our school and its core values, being a role model to others and working to present our vision and ethos at school and community events. Successful applicants will be made the Character Education Lead for their value when they move into Year 11.

The qualities you need to display: You need to be an effective communicator, you need to show that you are calm and respectful to others and that you take a keen interest in supporting the school and its community. You will be reliable and committed to doing your very best to maintain the highest standards of learning throughout the school and for yourself. You will be determined to model good behaviour and attitude across all aspects of school life at all times. You will be ambitious and driven.

What does the post require: You will be an ambassador for the values of our school, you will be asked to attend meetings within school and within the local community that promote our core values. You will be required to attend a fortnightly lunchtime meeting and take an active role in our assembly programme. You will be required to encourage all students and staff to participate in our Character Education programme. You will be responsible for signing off and celebrating student's success as part of Character Education.

You will apply to be a student deputy on one of the 5 core values of Five Acres High School. Please make it clear in your application which value you would like to lead on and the reasons why.

- **Ambition** – Enterprise, Academia and Futures
- **Creativity** – Talent, Appreciation and Culture
- **Confidence** – Oracy, Leadership and Adventure
- **Determination** – Sports, Literacy and Commitment (societies and academies)
- **Respect** – Service (volunteering), Diversity and Environment

- Evidence of the personal qualities you have for this role
- Examples of activities you have been involved with both in and outside of school which are likely to illustrate your capacity for this role
